SUBJECT: STATE FAIR CAREER TECHNOLOGY (SFCTC) FORMERLY VO-TECH				

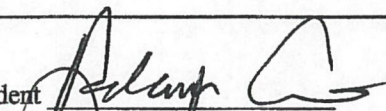
Policy Purpose: To provide high school students an opportunity to take advantage of the Career Technology Center (CTC) program offered at State Fair Community College (SFCC).

Policy Information: Students are offered SFCTC slots through their assigned public high schools free of charge by enrolling part time in the public school or by paying for the classes outright. To ensure efficient use of public school funds and administrative work at ACS and SFCC, the following requirements have been established for each student desiring to enter the program:

- 4530.1** Signed contract committing the applicant to a specific CTC program.
- 4530.2** Submit a one hundred word essay expressing the reasons they want to commit to their chosen program to ACS administration.
- 4530.3** Attend the CTC orientation at SFCC.
- 4530.4** Counsel with CTC counselor at SFCC.
- 4530.5** ACS is not obligated to alter schedules to accommodate CTC program, but other options are available to satisfy the credits needed for graduation.
- 4530.6** Approval by ACS Academic Committee.

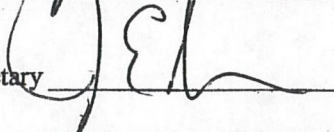
