SUBJECT: <b>RESPONSIBILITIES OF A BOARD MEMBER</b>				

**Policy Purpose:** Provide guidance as to the Responsibilities of a Board Member

**Policy Information:**

- 1015.1 To recognize God as the head of Applewood Christian School, and to seek God's counsel and glory in all decisions forthwith.
- 1015.2 To familiarize her/himself with the Applewood Christian School policies, regulations, and best practices of Christian Education.
- 1015.3 To have a general knowledge of educational aims and objectives of the Applewood Christian School.
- 1015.4 To work harmoniously with other board members without trying to neglect her/his share of the work.
- 1015.5 To vote and act in the board meetings impartially for the good of Applewood Christian School and Applewood Christian School Students consistent with its mission.
- 1015.6 To encourage active discussion and debate among board members but then accept the will of the majority vote in all cases and give support to the resulting decision.
- 1015.7 To represent the board and Applewood Christian School to the public in such a way as to promote both interest and support.
- 1015.8 It is important that a board member be nonpartisan in dealing with school matters and that she/he not subordinate the education of students to any partisan principle, group, interest, or personal ambition.
