STATE FAIR CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY CENTER (SFCTC)				

Policy Purpose: To provide high school students an opportunity to take advantage of the Career and Technology Center (CTC)


Policy Information: Students are offered SFCTC slots through their assigned public high schools free of charge by enrolling part time in the public school or by paying for the classes outright. To ensure efficient use of public school funds and administrative work at ACS and SFCC, the following requirements have been established for each student desiring to enter the program:

- 4530.1 Complete the SFCTC enrollment procedure. This process begins in late February/early March in Sophomore year.
- 4530.2 Submit a one hundred word essay expressing the reasons they want to commit to their chosen program at ACS administration.
- 4530.3 ACS is not obligated to alter schedules to accommodate SFCTC program, but other options are available to satisfy the credits needed for graduation.
- 4530.4 ACS credits will be determined based on the classes taken.
- 4530.5 Approval by ACS Academic Committee.
