 - HS Plan Night
 - New process well received
 - One family did not attend (3rd year in a row)
 - One student needs Advanced Math 1
 - Can graduate without this class if general diploma is chosen
 - AC: We ordinarily would not offer a class to one student.
 If it is required outside of general diploma, we would expect the family to pick it up outside of the school.
 - AF: If the family is paying tuition, are we required to offer a solution to the student.
 - KG: Historically, families pick up whatever is required; financially and additional work.
 - KG: If a dual credit, college course was taken and not passed, student would not graduate unless additional credits were added in advance.

- NS: Doesn't feel right not providing a teacher and not providing an alternative.
- DW: Feels we should ask if student is interested in taking this class one on one. It may not be an enjoyable experience.
- ACTION ITEM AF: Let family know we may not be able to offer a teacher for one student and offer some possible solutions.
- Policy 5010
 - 5010.7: "6 or more absences"
 - o Have told students they have 6 days to be absent
 - Is actually 5 days
 - KG: Should we enforce 5 days in the future or update the policy.
 - JG: Would like to keep the policy as is (for the number of days) and re-educate families that 5 is the limit
 - JG: Would like to add verbiage that covers not receiving credit for single class if single classes are missed (rather than not receiving credit for all classes)
 - AF: Asking if the board would enforce taking credit away, per the policy. If not, should be removed.
 - NS: Would like to see the 2007 version of the policy (the original intent).
 - ACTION ITEM JG: Find earlier copy of policy.
 - DW: Would like to know how public school deals with this:
 - AF/KG: Would be hot-lined
 - NS: Cannot answer if board would take away.
 Would need to analyze the details.
 - DW: We should add sending a letter to family with clear warning.
 - JG: Ultimately the policy exists as a warning to keep students from exceeding the limit. Hope to not have to enforce.
 - DW: Making sure we have excused absences
 - KG: Job shadowing, college visits, school events.
 - Sick is not excused even with a doctor's note.
 - Side note: recent investigation of historic documents, that we are now reinstituting
 - Asking students to seek scripture to deal with their disciplinary issues.
